## **Eligibility Criteria:**

- Acceptance or intent to enroll full time at an accredited community college or trade/vocational/technical school in the United States.
- Acceptance or intent to enroll for a minimum of 6 credit hours at an accredited community college or trade/vocational/technical school in the United States when the student can document working on average 20 or more hours per week throughout the entire term.
- US Citizen or eligible noncitizen graduate of Banks High School, Washington County, Oregon or equivalent home school degree from within the Banks School District boundary.
- Acceptance at or eligibility to enroll in a degree or certificate program, but not attending college or trade/vocational/technical school at the time of this application.
- Financial need and a pattern of grade improvement in academic performance throughout high school as evidenced by GPA, other grading criteria and/or letters of reference will both be highly prioritized.
- Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or other evidence of good academic standing.
